

## Alpha Phi Omega Section 80 Most Improved Chapter

The Section 80 most improved chapter is to recognize the chapter that has improved the most in exemplifying Leadership, Friendship & Service. This is awarded based on the chapter's overall program accomplishments and efforts. Nominations should highlight, but are not limited to, the following criteria:

1. The chapter has improved its program and efforts in the following areas:
  - attendance at LDWs
  - leadership roles on campus and in their community (E.g. sponsoring a scouting organization, serving on campus or community councils, etc.)
  - interacting with other chapters either through initiating other chapters to visit or visits to other campuses
  - hosting or participating in sectional, regional or national events
  - improving their service program by adding new projects that encompass all 4 areas of service
2. The chapter has striven to increase membership and membership retention.
3. The chapter has met all sectional, regional and national obligations.

Nominations for this award must be submitted to the awards committee chairperson by the stated deadline. Nominations should be no more than a 1 page summary of reasons why the chapter qualifies as an award nominee (please see cover sheet that accompanied this letter). The awards committee shall select the recipient of this award based upon nominations received by the deadline. Anyone can nominate a chapter for this award.
