- Nationals year: All chapters need to be in good standing by November 15th. Charter Reaffirmation and AAMDs along with early Convention registration by 11/15. Also need to pay Section 80 dues. These dues go to awards and anything that the section needs. Make checks payable to APO-Lambda Nu Chapter because they hold the sectional treasury for the Sectionals Conference. Send Lambda Nu the checks (Section Treasurer). The address will be mailed out on the Listserve. Make sure that you put this in the mail before it is due!
- Pledge forms and fees are due within 10 days of the ceremony for both Inductions and Initiations.
- Convention: Early registration is due by 11/15. Register on convention.apo.org. Fee goes up if you register after this. Do not put registration in the same check as AAMDs.
- NCPCs are going to be held to get voting delegates ready for convention. Here you will learn about what it is like to be on the floor, as well as what to do in Denver. Dos and Don'ts are good for everyone to hear. Anyone can attend an NCPC, but it is required for voting delegates.
